Children take part in teams of four to swim, cycle and run for charity! The triathlon is a fun way to introduce children to a new sport whilst also learning important fundraising skills and values. Since 2015, the Schools Triathlon has raised over £1 million for Restless Development and over 60 other charities. Last year, 3,300 children raised an amazing £465,000!

When? Sunday 17th May 2020

Who can enter? Anyone in school years 3-8

**How much?** There is no registration fee however each participant must fundraise a target of £100, with a minimum of £50 to take part.

**How far?** We encourage children with a range of abilities, from competitive teams to those who just want to have a fun day out with friends. Teams complete the course as a relay. Each team member will complete a certain distance of each sporting discipline. Distances will vary depending on your age group.
